Audience Troupe directors may award points on an hourly basis for attending productions, or they may award .5 point for attending a production *and* writing a substantial critique or report demonstrating the educational value of the experience.

Thespian Honor Rank Summary (see <i>Thespian Troupe Handbook</i> for details)		
Thespian points earned	Thespian rank	Honor may be signified by...
15	Thespian	Thespian induction. Membership card, certificate, and induction pin awarded.
20-50	1- to 4-star Thespian	Induction pin and 1 to 4 Thespian point stars are affixed to ITS honors ribbon. 1 to 4 paper stars are added to membership certificate.
60	Honor Thespian (5-star Thespian)	All Thespian point stars removed from ITS honors ribbon. Honor Thespian pin replaces point stars. Paper honor bar added to membership certificate.
70-110	6- to 10-star Thespian	One point star added to honors ribbon for <i>each</i> additional 10 points earned.
120	National Honor Thespian (11-star Thespian).	All point stars removed from ITS honors ribbon. National Honor Thespian pin replaces Honor Thespian pin.
130-170	12- to 16-star Thespian	One point star added to honors ribbon for <i>each</i> additional 10 points earned.
180	International Honor Thespian (17-star Thespian)	All Thespian point stars removed from ITS honors ribbon. International Honor Thespian pin replaces National Honor Thespian pin.

How Do I Know How Many Points I Have???

*****Two things are important to consider when calculating points for the International Thespian Society...LENGTH of the show and SIZE of the role.**

Look at the following scenarios for guidance...

1. Curly in OKLAHOMA! = 8 pts (Major Role in a Full Length Show)
2. Fred in OKLAHOMA! = 5 pts (Minor Role in a Full Length Show)
3. Carl in A NICE FAMILY GATHERING = 4 pts (Major Role in a One Act)
4. Sergeant #1 in TARTUFFE = 1 pt (Walk-on in a One Act)

-THINGS TO REMEMBER...

- Any Theatre I/II/III/IV class play is a ONE ACT
- If it has an intermission, it is a full length (if it doesn't, it's a one act)
- Major roles are RARE, reserved for leading roles with 100+ lines.
- In an ensemble show with no true "lead" all roles are considered MINOR
- 5 points carry over from Middle School (ONLY if your MS had an official JrITS troupe)
- Half of your points can come from Non-RHS performances (ie Church, Professional performances, Camps, etc.)
- The Troupe Director (Smith) can give additional points for miscellaneous theatre activities...email her with questions about competitions, seeing performances, etc. Do NOT ask her in the middle of class ☺

GENERAL POINT AMOUNTS SPECIFIC TO ROUSE HIGH SCHOOL THEATRE 2014/2015

Working a Concession Stand – 1 shift = 1 point, 2 shifts (whole time) = 2 points

Pep Rally Performance – 2 points per performance

Trunk or Treat – Part time = 1 point, Whole night = 2 points

ITS in Dallas – 3 points for attending, 2 points for performing in an IE

RenFest – 2 points for attending, 2 points for performing in Duet, Group Scene or Monologue, 1 point walk-on in OAP, 2 points minor role in OAP, 4 points major role in OAP

Royals, Show Choir or Broadcast Journalism – 1 point per performance up to 8 points total per year

Mr. Maroon – Contestant = 2 points, Assisted performers = 1 point

UIL OAP Clinic – 2 points per clinic

UIL OAP Host Crew – 5 points for working all day

College Scholarship Auditions – 1 point per audition

Crew for any non-theatre event – 1 point per event

Crew for Mr. Maroon, Royals Spring Show, Show Choir Spring Show, Theatre I-IV Showcase, Hollywood Night – 2 points per event

The following are not points so do not ask...ROTC, Marching Band, Athletics, Class Presentations (including videos, speeches and monologues), Theatre Classwork (i.e. monologues, auditions, projects, etc.), Journalism/Newspaper, Library Club, Key Club, Latin Club, and being an officer on any random club.
