

Thespian Point Allowances for Non-theatrical Performances

****Non-theatrical Performances can make up no more than ¼ of an International Thespian Society Student's total points for awards and nomination for membership. The majority of points must be earned in theatrical events at RHS.
(Example: A student has 40 total points, up to 10 of those points can be Non-theatrical Performances.)*

Show Choir = 6 points per year

Choir at RHS = 2 points per year

Private Voice Lessons = 1 point per year

Royals/Dance Team = 6 points per year

Dance Class at RHS = 2 points per year

Dance Class outside RHS = 1 point per year

Cheerleading = 6 points per year

Marching Band = 1 point per year

Color Guard = 1 point per year

Winter Guard = 1 point per year

ROTC = 1 point per year

Destination Imagination = 4 points per year

Speech = 2 points per year (See point sheet for individual events at speech competitions.)

Broadcast Journalism = 2 points per year

Student Council Officer = 1 point per year

Other Club Officer (ie Key Club, Spanish Honor Society, NHS, etc.) = 1 point per year

Pep Rally MC = 1 point per year

Other Event MC (ie Prom, Project Grad, Announcer at Football Games, etc.) = 1 point per year

Auto Tech/Mechanics/Ag Mechanics = 1 point per year

Art/Design = 1 point per year

Service to the Organization Points

****ITS allows points to be given for Thespian Society community service/fundraiser activities because they support the organizations success. Here is the breakdown of these events at RHS and their point values.*

Varsity Football Concession Stand = 2 points each time (1 shift)

RHS Homecoming Parade Participation = 1 point

Trunk or Treat = 2 points

Texas Thespian Convention = 3 points (1 per day)

Participation in IE = 2 points

Participation in Unified Auditions = 2 points

Community Service Project (example: Trick or Treat So Kids Can Eat) = 2 points

RHS Fundraiser Participation (example: participation in Lanyard sales) = 1 point

RHS Theatre Promotional Booths (example: Meet the Raiders, Freshman Orientation, etc.) = 1 point each time

Pep Rally Skit/Performance = 2 points

ITS Social Events (example: Movie Night, Seeing a Performance, Cast Party, After show dinner, etc.) = 1 point each time

****Note: ITS social events do not count unless they were organized ahead of time and ALL ITS members were formally invited to the event.*

BREAKDOWN OF POINTS and MEMBERSHIP ELIGIBILITY:

No more than ¼ of a members total points can be NON-THEATRICAL PERFORMANCES (see list above)

No more than ¼ of a members total points can be from OUTSIDE PERFORMANCES (church, community theatre, etc.)

Students must have points from being involved in at least TWO after school productions (fall show, musical, oap)

Students must have points in at least TWO point categories (Acting and Tech, Acting and House, Acting and Speech, etc.)

In order to maintain eligibility and earn points members must remain active in the theatre department at Rouse HS.

In order to remain active –

- students must be registered in a theatre class OR participate in at least one extra-curricular show that school year (fall show, musical, or oap)
- attend at least **TWO** ITS meetings
- attend at least **ONE** ITS community service project or fundraising event

Inactive members cannot participate in ITS activities or receive awards during that school year (this includes graduation cords).

Students can be reactivated the following year.
